

Aldham Parish Council requests an accompanied site visit to the village to understand the impact of the proposal at following locations:

1. Impact on residential amenity at Hines Close, Aldham CO6 3RL of Pylons TB055-TB057. This can be observed from the public highway (Hines Close and Brook Road) and also from PRow FP15 that runs west - east from Brook Road south of Hines Close and is crossed by the Pylon Route, but would better viewed from private rear gardens if possible,
2. Impact on the setting of Grade II* St Margaret's Church when viewed from the south. This can also be viewed from Brook Road travelling north at the point the OH line crosses Brook Road between Pylons TB57 and 58, just north of Aldham Hall,
3. The impact of Grade II* listed buildings at Aldham Hall when travelling south on Brook Road and from PRow FP15,
4. Landscape impact on Colne Valley and Ford Street Conservation Area when travelling down Ford Hill on A1124 where line crosses between TB53 and 54, and
5. Landscape impact on Roman River Valley of Pylons TB61-64, when viewed from south of bridge over Sudbury-Marks Tey Branch Line on PRow FP22, accessed on foot from Rectory Road, adjacent Church House Farm.
