

please note that my family and i fully object to the current proposal, and support the alternative route and design suggestions put forward by Essex & Suffolk pylons group. On a personal level my family and i are all ready struggling with the projects impact. The prospect of unsightly pylons marring our countryside and disrupting wildlife habitats troubles us. Should NG proceed, the installation of 50metre pylons would undoubtedly disrupt our local community our narrow road which is already busy regularly floods causing damage to houses and cars in the area, i can't imagine what it would be like if the project gets the go ahead!!!. Traffic noise, pollution, and potential health implications all loom large. Concerns about cancer risks arising from close proximity to such installations only further our anxieties. Our property is a listed building and the land is included in the curtilage of it. Recent visit from estate agents have estimated a depreciation in value by 30-40 percent. Having invested our time, hard efforts and personal finances into our homes this revelation is deeply upsetting. We have received a plan from NG proposing that a corner of our land/paddocks lie within the shaded green area identified as the zone for permanent assets. Within that zone stands ancient oaks and stables for our horses. These oak trees are keystone in the local ecosystem. Their removal would cause disproportionate harm to local biodiversity. They are centuries old and cannot be meanfully replaced within a reasonable timeframe. They also contribute significantly to the amenity value of the land. Also within the affected area are stables, during construction the stables would likely need to be relocated to insure adequate distance from works. This would cause stress to he horses and to address safety concerns.

To surround one property with three of these is unreasonable and unfair.

We propose that the project go underground or offshore alternatives be looked at, we also ask that the existing pylons that are featured near our house now which has been proposed as being put underground be upgraded instead.
