

Further to my previous feedback submitted on 27th November 2025, I would like to confirm that my position remains unchanged.

In addition, I would like to raise further concerns regarding the potential impact of the electromagnetic field produced by the pylons on the operation of the wedding venue. As the venue is located in a field without access to Wi-Fi, we rely heavily on mobile phone signal. DJs depend on phone data to download and stream music, we use mobile signal to process card payments at the bar, and guests rely on it to book taxis at the end of the evening or in the worst-case scenario, in case of emergency.


I am concerned that the electromagnetic field produced by the installation of pylons so close could interfere with mobile phone reception, which would significantly affect our ability to operate the venue effectively.

I also operate a shepherd's hut as an Airbnb property. Due to its remote location, it does not have Wi-Fi and is entirely dependent on a reliable mobile phone signal. Any disruption to this service would therefore have a direct impact on the business.

I would like to formally request the opportunity to speak at the appropriate open-floor hearing during the enquiry process. Please keep me informed of the relevant dates and arrangements.

As an affected landowner, with the proposed pylon route crossing our farm, I would also like to request an accompanied site visit (as on private land) to discuss the proposals I submitted on 27th November 2025 in more detail. I believe it is important for you to see the location in person to fully understand the context and the implications on the ground.

There are a number of other landowners impacted by the proposed route who would be willing to attend and support a meeting (accompanied site visit) regarding our alternative route proposal and additional growing concerns. Please could you contact me with your available dates, or advise me on the appropriate person to speak to in order to arrange this.
