

Remus Animal Sanctuary , [REDACTED]

The close proximity is 75 metres from the boundary of the animals field. A 20 metre base is required for the pylon and a 50 metre working area which equates to a distance of only 5 metres to the boundary of the field. This will have an immense impact on the animals and due to the frequent flooding of the area rendering the the adjoining fields sterile will make it impossible to move the animals to other fields during construction. The haul road in the position it is in will cause distress to the animals. The pylon line would be better situated further to the east away from the sanctuary boundary.

I would request the lines to go underground, to maintain the local farmers fields and livelihoods, and allowing the St Marys Church , Buttsbury to keep its rural view.
