Document: 8.4.5 Applicant's Draft Itinerary for Accompanied Site Inspection

Final Issue A

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1. Introduction

- 1.1.1 On the 13th January 2026, the Planning Inspectorate published its ‘Rule 6’ letter providing the draft examination timetable for the Norwich to Tilbury Development Consent application. Annex B and Annex F of the letter set out the procedure for the Accompanied Site Inspections (ASI) for the project.
- 1.1.2 The ExA requested that Interested Parties submit their suggested locations for an ASI by deadline 1. The applicant was requested in the ‘Rule 6’ letter to prepare a draft itinerary for the ASI to include:
- relevant locations referred to in the relevant representations received
 - any other locations at which the applicant has predicted likely significant environmental effects
 - the locations suggested by IPs submitted by deadline 1
- 1.1.3 Annex F of the letter continues to state:
- 1.1.4 *‘The order limits for the Norwich to Tilbury Project are extensive in length and area. There is unlikely to be sufficient time in the examination for the ExA to visit all sites which are suggested.’*
- 1.1.5 *‘The ExA will then consider each suggested site location which has not already been visited and decide whether it would assist the examination of the application to visit that location.’*
- 1.1.6 *‘The ExA will also determine if it could be viewed unaccompanied from public land, on an access required basis, or if it is necessary to view it on an accompanied basis.’*
- 1.1.7 Considering the requirements of Annex B & Annex F of the letter, the applicant has prepared a draft itinerary set out in Table 1.1.
- 1.1.8 The draft itinerary includes locations where the applicant has predicted likely significant environmental effects (moderate-major to high). Locations for visits have been combined with suggestions put forward in the relevant representations, written representations and any other suggested locations submitted at deadline 1.
- 1.1.9 Where multiple requests have been received for a similar location, these have been grouped to a single location for efficiency. The Applicant has made use of suggested viewpoints as set out in *6.13.F7 Environmental Statement – Visual Receptors and Viewpoints* to observe elements of the route.
- 1.1.10 The ExA has suggested that it may consider it appropriate to undertake visits on an accompanied and unaccompanied basis. The itinerary proposed in Table 1.1 has been limited to those sites without access from public land where accompanied site inspection would be required. An alternative, combined itinerary is proposed in Table 1.2 which lists all the locations gathered as instructed in the Rule 6 letter should the ExA wish to visit during the site inspections.

- 1.1.11 The majority of the suggested locations are publicly accessible and could be undertaken as part of an unaccompanied site inspection, where this is the case, it has been identified in the table in Table 1.2.
- 1.1.12 The suggested timings for the visits have been based on the actual travel time between locations, allowing for 15 minutes at each stop. This currently results in a single long day of the ASI. The Applicant will review these timings once the ExA has confirmed the locations for the final itinerary, with the possibility of splitting the visit over two days. As part of the final itinerary, accompanying maps will also be provided at that stage.
