Application by National Grid Electricity Transmission (the Applicant) for an Order Granting Development Consent for the Norwich to Tilbury Project (Planning Inspectorate Reference EN020027)

Submission of Proposed Change Application 2 for a Proposed Change (Change Request 2) to the Development Consent Order Application

Little Bromley: Change to the EACN access (Change Request 2)

- 1.1.1 The Applicant refers to its letter to the Examining Authority dated 12 December 2025 **[AS-050]** which notified the Examining Authority of the Applicant's intention to apply to make a change to the application for the Project (the Proposed Change Application 2).
- 1.1.2 Accordingly, this letter and its enclosures constitutes the Proposed Change Application 2.
- 1.1.3 As set out in **AS-050**, the purpose of the Proposed Change Application 2 is to amend the Order Limits in order to support a small modification to the route of the Applicant's construction access (for use when a third-party access is not available) and a further small modification to the route for the private permanent Abnormal Indivisible Load (AIL) access route to the proposed East Anglian Connection Node (EACN) substation (hereby referred to as Change Request 2 (Little Bromley)).
- 1.1.4 In parallel to this application, the Applicant has also submitted a separate application (Proposed Change Application 1) for a separate design change at Bulphan (Change Request 1 (Bulphan)). The background to Change Request 1 (Bulphan) was provided in the Applicant's separate notification letter (see **9.1 Notification of proposed change to DCO application – Change Request 1 (Bulphan) [AS-049]**). The Applicant's Proposed Change Application 1 for the design change at Bulphan was submitted by the Applicant to the Examining Authority on 27 March 2026.
- 1.1.5 The Applicant has considered the Planning Inspectorate's (2024) advice: Nationally Significant Infrastructure Projects: Changes to an application after it has been accepted for examination (PINS Guidance 2024) and the Infrastructure Planning

(Compulsory Acquisition) Regulations 2010 (CA Regulations) in preparing Proposed Change Application 2.

1.1.6 Enclosed with this application (Proposed Change Application 2) are the following documents, required under Regulation 5 of the CA Regulations:



- Proposed Change Application 2: Overview Report – Change Request 2 (Little Bromley) [**document reference 9.6**], which includes a description and rationale for the proposed change.
- Proposed Change Application 2: Schedule of Changes to DCO Application Documents - Change Request 2 (Little Bromley) [**document reference 9.8**], which lists consequential revisions to each document and plan or a “no change” annotation.
- Proposed Change Application 2: Consultation Report - Change Request 2 (Little Bromley) [**document reference 9.10**], which provides details of the targeted consultation undertaken by the Applicant between 19 January 2026 and 23 February 2026, including confirmation of who was consulted, how the Applicant has considered consultation responses in finalising its proposals and copies of all consultation responses received.
- Proposed Change Application 2: Addendum to Environmental Statement - Change Request 2 (Little Bromley) [**document reference 9.12**], which confirms that the proposed change would not result in any new or different likely significant effects.

- 1.1.8 The Applicant is aware that, in the event that the Proposed Change Application 2 (and, as the case may be, the Proposed Change Application 1) is or are accepted by the Examining Authority, consequential amendments or updates will be required to be made to a number of other plans and documents (for example, to reflect changes to the Order Limits). These documents are set out in Proposed Change Application 2: Schedule of Changes to DCO Application Documents - Change Request 2 (Little Bromley) [**document reference 9.8**] and Proposed Change Application 1: Schedule of Changes to DCO Application Documents - Change Request 1 (Bulphan) [**document reference 9.7**].
- 1.1.9 The Applicant intends to submit those updated plans and documents at Deadline 4 (12 May 2026).
- 1.1.10 The Applicant considers that subject to the Examining Authority's agreement, Change Request 2 (Little Bromley) can be accommodated in the statutory timescale of the examination given. It should be noted that:
- Change Request 2 (Little Bromley) is not substantial (both in and of itself and also when considered cumulatively alongside Change Request 1 (Bulphan)) and that the inclusion of the change would not result in a materially different project;
 - No new or different likely significant environmental effects to those reported in the Environmental Statement have been identified as a result of Change Request 2 (Little Bromley) (either in isolation or in combination with Change Request 1 (Bulphan));
 - All parties likely to be affected by, or who have interest in, Change Request 2 (Little Bromley), were consulted in advance of submission of Proposed Change Application 2; and
 - The submission of Change Request 2 (Little Bromley), at this stage, provides sufficient time to review and examine any relevant concerns that may emerge relating to the proposed change.
- 1.1.11 We trust that the documents submitted in support of Change Request 2 (Little Bromley) provide a clear explanation and justification for the proposed change to the submitted DCO application.
