I must make the Planning Inspectorate aware that National Grid appear to have failed completely in recognising the importance of the valley in which [REDACTED] sits. This Grade 11 listed property dates back to 1453 and has significant history including Roman pottery and even Roman leg-irons found on-site.

When we bought this property in the mid-Eighties my lawyer told me (in writing) that this area was part of a country conservation area. That protection doesn't seem to resonate with National Grid of course.

Recently a regional councillor ([REDACTED]) paid a visit to this valley and said he thought it was actually more beautiful than the adjoining Dedham Vale.

It would be nothing short of sacrilege to construct 50 metre high pylons across this valley. This is 2026 not 1926.

As it stands, the planned pylons will be just 200 metres from our house..and even that is not thought through. They could be set much further back in the field.

These cables must go underground. This valley must be preserved.
