1. Possible medieval site.
2. Complex cropmarks, Roman road passes through here.
3. "Moated site" confirmed at least from AD1250.
4. Trackways leading from moated site.
5. Roman road passes through here.
6. Prehistoric site, extensive flint working.
7. Confirmed Roman site.
8. Cropmarks suggest building, period unknown.
9. Confirmed Roman site.
10. Likely Roman building.
11. Confirmed Roman site.
12. Possible Roman site.
13. Cropmarks suggest enclosure and building, field is called House Field.
14. Roman road passes through here.
15. Cropmarks and geophysics suggest early building, period unknown.
16. Complex, multi period site, including tile kiln.
17. Roman road appears to split here.
18. Roman road turns here.
19. Probable Roman site.
20. Ring ditches, Bronze Age burials.
21. Known Roman road showing strongly on cropmarks.

22. Site of early cottages, possible earlier still site.
23. Ring ditches, Bronze Age burials.
24. Trackway/road shown on aerial photos.
25. Site of Fossetts farm, moated site.
26. Cropmarks show two rows of post holes, Saxon?
27. Possible archaeology extending from dig site.
28. Active Roman dig site with Stone, Bronze and Iron Age finds. Roman buildings, including a bathhouse. Roman and Saxon burials.
29. Trackways leading to Fossetts farm.
30. Confirmed Roman archaeology in south of dig field.
31. Ring ditch, Bronze Age burial.
32. Ditto.
33. Cropmarks show enclosures next to river, possible early (Saxon?) mill site.
