Dear Norwich to Tilbury Case Team,

Thank you for confirming our attendance at the accompanied site inspection.

Having now reviewed the published itinerary, I note that neither [REDACTED] form part of the published inspection route.

I am concerned by this, as our objections relate to highly site-specific impacts affecting both our residential property, our farming operations, and associated family land interests that cannot properly be understood from plans or written submissions alone.

Our representations include:

- Proposed construction access through our residential entrance at [REDACTED]
- Contractor and vehicle movements in close proximity to our family home and children
- Safeguarding and privacy concerns arising from construction access through domestic space
- Significant poultry biosecurity risks and potential loss of commercial contracts
- Impacts on cattle grazing, livestock management, and day-to-day farm operations
- Impacts on associated family farming land at [REDACTED]
- The existence of a viable alternative access route which would avoid these impacts

These are physical, site-specific impacts which are best understood through direct inspection.

We would therefore respectfully request that [REDACTED] and the relevant land interests associated with both, are considered for inclusion within either:

1. A future accompanied site inspection; or
2. Any future unaccompanied site inspection undertaken by the Examining Authority.

Given the significance of the residential, safeguarding, agricultural, and business impacts raised in our written representations and oral submissions, we would be grateful if this request could be formally placed on the examination record.
