It's not easy to find the areas that will affect our homes but I'm now a bit clearer than before.

It's not only the impact on our houses but also on the local wildlife.

Looking at the map I can see as far as the allotments north of Oakley Park, Mulbarton but not sure still if these high pylons are proposed to be erected in the next field or the one after. Let's hope the field even after that as it's going to be such an eyesore to put up with for the benefit of others (if it's a benefit) I believe these pylons will take the green energy through Norfolk (and Suffolk & Essex) to Tilbury and ultimately London whom I guess will not have any pylons.

Like many residents, not only dog walkers but the green areas are extremely valued. We have a good population of Green Woodpeckers which are beautiful as well as Red Kites, Buzzard and other usual birds and wildlife.

The National Grid states this is a vital upgrade that needs to be done. Is this actually true? Or is it just the Nat Grid telling us that. I do worry about the environmental impact and carbon impact to the environment. All this metal or steel dragged around the country. If it does ever go ahead let's hope it's UK steel not imported.

When I asked The Nat Grid for the total project cost they didn't know. Perhaps they do now?

Yes if you have a site visit near Mulbarton's houses I would like to join if possible.
