I was particularly aggrieved to note that the schedule for the day does not include the Colne Valley. This is a particularly beautiful area that will be desecrated by National Grid if their plans are allowed to go ahead. I know that there are many other areas where this project will have a devastating effect.

As a general point I am very surprised to note that the planning Inspectorate intend to spend such a short time considering the project's impact physically bearing in mind the magnitude of the project and the huge number of people that will be so badly affected if it goes ahead. I would have expected that much greater import would have been given to such matters.
