We are agents to Gent Fairhead and Co Ltd. Gent Fairhead and Co Ltd hold the benefit of the registered Option to dig sand and gravel from [REDACTED]

Previously we have written in to the Planning Inspectorate but in addition now wish to be heard by the Planning Inspectorate Inquiry .

Our concern relates to the alignment and Pylon/Tower placement location as currently proposed by the Norwich to Tilbury Grid upgrade scheme.

The location at Monks Farm relates to Towers/Pylons TB84, TB85 and TB86.

We would respectfully request that TB85 particularly is relocated approximately 200metres southwards from its currently shown position. In doing so TB85 will remain within the Draft Order Limits.

If TB85 is relocated in this way then significant amounts of sand and gravel will no longer be sterilised.

We should like to appear and be heard by the Planning Inspectorate so please can you let us know where the Inquiry will be sitting and when we should attend.

We look forward to your advice as soon as possible.
