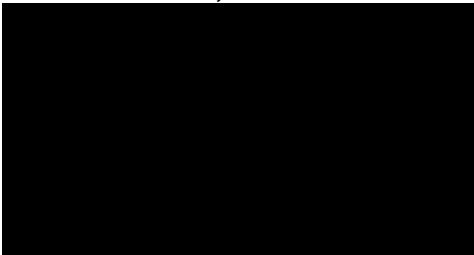

Dear Susan Hunt

With respect to the site visit on 27th May, we note that our location is not included. We note that several of the locations that are included relate to the need to assess the pylons wrt listed buildings. The route as it goes through the northern part of Rivenhall parish, where we live, is within direct line of sight of the Grade 1 listed Rivenhall church, which also includes a Scheduled Ancient Monument, the Grade 2* Rivenhall Place, which also includes historic parkland and the route also passes very close to veteran trees (National Grid agrees it does) and the ancient woodland Rivenhall Thicks - as well as our homes.

Can you please advise as to whether this area has already been inspected, or will be in the coming months.
