1. Deadline 5 - Registration to Attend Compulsory Acquisition Hearing

We understand that the Deadline 5 submissions for the notification of a wish to attend hearings on the week commencing 22 June 2026 was due by 10th June 2026. We apologise for the lateness of this submission, but in light of very limited progress with regard to discussions on protective provisions, we would be grateful if the Examining Authority would exercise its discretion to accept this notice to attend after the specified period.
