Dear Harrison

Thank you for clarifying the reference numbers and arranging for me to be contacted on both counts by email in future.

You do not say if [REDACTED] Farmhouse will be marked as listed on the project maps in future. Please can you confirm this. I would like my email and attachment to be added to the records in time to meet Deadline 6.

Having checked the route the pair of inspectors who carried out the UVI on the morning of 30th April it seems impossible that they could have done more than make a cursory glance at the locations which I suspect they may not have previously visited. From my personal professional experience of making site visits to single locations to assess or record their heritage impact, I think even tackling one section of the route in a whole morning would be necessary to get a full understanding of the issues. Did they just drive past [REDACTED] Farmhouse and tick a box, or did they look at in terms of its proximity to the proposed line of pylons which will be with 250 m north-east of the property? Or consider the impact the construction traffic will make on life here for the duration of the construction - should it take place.

Did they consider the impact on the landscape heritage - in other words distant views towards church towers, or clumps of woodland which are so important to maintaining the integrity of the rural landscape. By slicing through these unspoilt rural landscapes with pylons that dwarf any existing feature, the countryside will effectively become industrialised in a way that takes no account of centuries of built and natural heritage. This particularly the case in the relatively flat landscape in south Norfolk such as the plateau around Tibenham or across the Waverney valley south of Roydon.

Another point which is relevant to the area south of Tibenham is the proximity of the proposed pylons to Tibenham Airfield. Having lived here for many years I am familiar with how low aircraft are at the point they fly over our house and having checked on the CAA website, I can see that the current proposed route for the pylons is too close to Tibenham Airfield and the private Priory Farm airstrip. Please can you let me know what is being done to mitigate this.

Further to the two very helpful telephone conversations I had with one of your advisers on Thursday 11th June concerning my house not marked as a Listed Building on the Norwich to Tilbury pylons project map, I attach the requested information to enable you to identify the house and correct the information on your documents.

I have clearly marked the house on the location maps taken from the Norwich to Tilbury. They are pasted onto a Word document to reduce the size of the attachment. I have also provided links to the Official List entry and location map on the Historic England listing on the same document.

I should add that the map you use is not accurate as there is a third single storey former farm building (on the south side of the yard in front to the house. Since it is within the curtilage of the house, it is part of the listing. You will see that this building is correctly marked on the Historic England map.

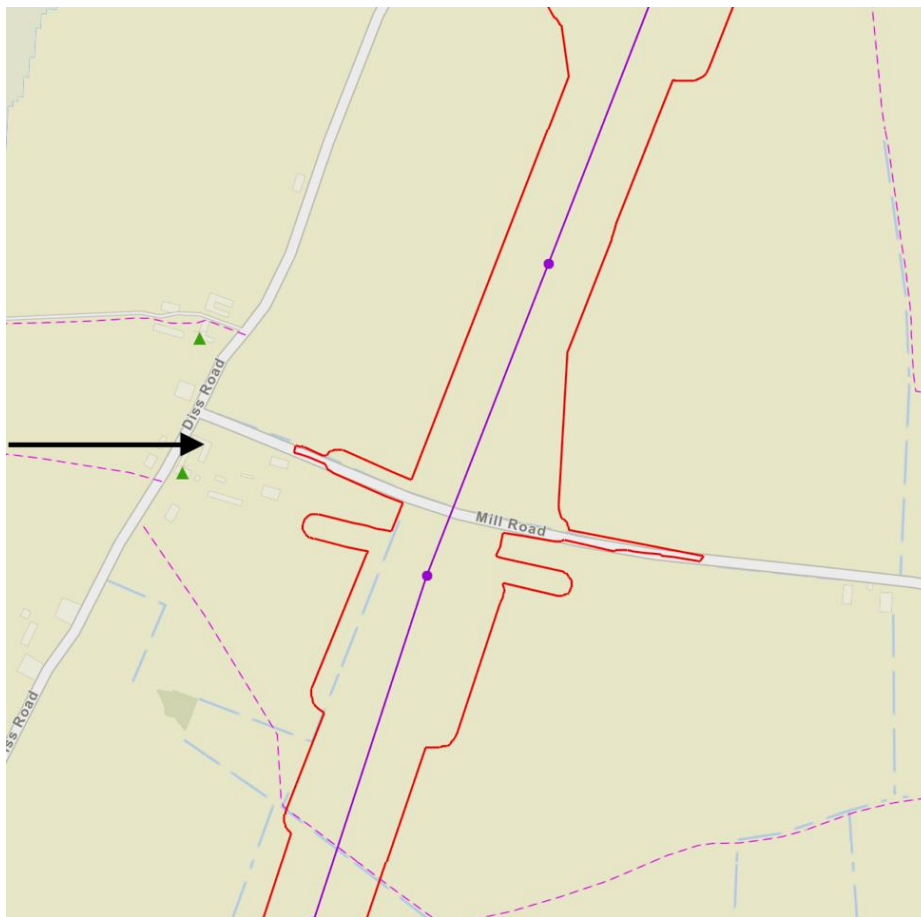
