1. Great Horkesley Parish Council continues to be concerned about the impact on the Dedham Vale National Landscape (part of which falls within our Parish) of the proposed infrastructure, and in particular the proposed sealing end compounds within and next to Great Horkesley.
 2. The countryside within and surrounding our Parish is of real worth. This includes the Dedham Vale National Landscape and the Colne Valley (we endorse the view of the two independent landscape assessments in respect of the latter).
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1. Both proposed sealing end compounds and associated infrastructure within the Parish and adjacent to it are sited too close to the National Landscape and other special areas including the Colne Valley, and are within their setting, and will have an adverse impact upon them. The visibility will be widespread and intrusive and cause permanent harm. Both the Dedham Vale National Landscape, and the Colne Valley and surroundings are special in value and deserve protecting. The local area is characterised by a tranquil setting and big skies.
 2. The impact on special and protected landscape should not be overridden by costs considerations, as National Grid appear to do.
