Dear Examining Authority,

Norwich to Tilbury Development Consent Order

We act on behalf of Cadent Gas Limited ("Cadent") in relation to the application for the Norwich to Tilbury Development Consent Order (the "Application").

With reference to the content of our previous submissions, we now advise that commercial terms between the Applicant and Cadent have been agreed, and that these have now been formalised by way of a completed agreement. There is, therefore, now no disagreement regarding the protective provisions benefitting Cadent that appeared in the draft Development Consent Order submitted at Deadline 7 (examination library reference pending).

Please could this letter be shared with the Secretary of State and Cadent's formal notice of the withdrawal of their existing representations regarding the Application [REP1-217, REP1-218].
