

NG have not listened to or acted upon any of the objections that have been made.

We have been given a fait accompli with no options other than pylons. How can this even be a consultation when no other options are given??? The submissions to the Inspectorate have shown time and again the dismal failure of NG to meet their responsibilities, simply acting as though it were already a done deal. They have given no answer to health concerns of people living close to such high level power lines or the desperately low mental health of people affected. They just carry on steam rolling their way over human beings.

There is a severe risk of pollution in the Forncett area and in the Tas valley, there would be a very negative effect on local wildlife. Brown hares, 73 species of birds, 22 species of butterflies, Roe Deer are just some of the creatures seen around my home, for all their bluster, NG cannot definitively say these will return post pylon destruction.

The harm to farmland will be huge, we need to be producing maximum crops not reducing good farming land with metal, concrete and haul roads. Footpaths all around us will be closed, our properties are already devalued, houses are not selling and those that are on the market are having to repeatedly drop their pricing in order to try and get some interest.

This is the biggest investment people make and NG are whittling it away with impunity.

I would respectfully implore the Planning Inspectorate to refuse this application.
