

I am the owner and director of Heron Meadow Care Farm, Roydon near Diss. It is a retreat centre, a place for healing in and learning from Nature. I have explained that the N2T pylons will pass directly adjacent to my meadow, close to where it crosses the river Waveney, creating severe environmental disruption and pollution by EMF, effectively destroying my business.

However, what I would most wish to impress upon this members of this enquiry is that it falls to all of us - but of course particularly to those who are tasked with making decisions which impact upon it - to protect the environment, the landscape and all the fragile ecosystems of our precious countryside. This is vital, it is of far greater significance in terms of the future survival of our own as well as other remaining species to come up with better solutions to the need for distributed power networks. The current application is poorly thought through, it has been rushed, it employs old ideas and technologies.

Please demand that alternatives, for instance off-shore or undergrounded DC networks, are properly costed and considered.

We are entrusting the natural beauty and biodiversity of East Anglia to you, please protect it for future generations.
