6 Never thought we would see the day in the UK where decent law abiding communities are being walked all over.

7 There will be areas of the sanctuary we will need to change to try to ease the impact on the animals

8 We are a smaller Sanctuary with over 100 large animals offering a necessary service to the public trying to make ends meet following years of not being able to fundraise due to covid then we were hit with the cost of living crisis, the increased NMW and National Insurance and now the drought conditions that are impacting us greatly with no grass and having to feed hay much earlier now we are also faced with the impact on our business from the noise and dirt and people and vehicles doing as they wish without any respect from the people , land or areas they are destroying and the definite impact this will have on our fundraising at the Sanctuary

9 It's a sham and clearly already has the green light despite supposedly waiting for planning permission.

10. Please rethink. Please go underground if you must go ahead Please consider the communities that you are impacting.

11. We have already been lied to and treated like rubbish by people working on the surveys etc and this can only get worse
