

I want to reiterate my concerns and my stance against the proposed pylons that I sent in Nov 2025. These have not changed. Nothing has been done to put my mind at ease, in fact quite the opposite.

The plans for Roydon Fen and Wortham Ling areas are not suitable for such nature rich, well visited areas. More trees to attempt to soften the giant pylons in the landscape are not suitable for the type of habitat these areas have. A heathland and fenland both need to be open areas, free of more trees. That would simply not suit these landscapes or the rare wildlife they support.

We are concerned about the destruction to our local area, to our wildlife, during construction and after.

Our houses will lose value and be hard to sell, essentially trapping people into their homes. This just is not fair. We won't be compensated for such losses.

The mental health of myself, my partner and my neighbours has all been in decline because of the concern that this disastrous project goes ahead. We are worried and quite simply scared, for ourselves, for our local area, for our finances and for our local habitats.

Please do not scar our countryside and destroy our home.
