

As a party who will be affected by this proposed line of pylons running through the heart of Forncett St Peter where I live I have very closely followed the proposals put forward by National Grid over the last few years and in particular during this examination period.

The real concerns of residents in relation to health, mental wellbeing, loss of property values, loss of countryside amenities, affects on businesses, irreversible damage to rare chalk streams and SSSI sites, affect on listed heritage assets, damage to wildlife habitats and biodiversity corridors have still not been properly addressed by the applicant. Throughout the examination period the applicant has consistently failed to address all of these issues when pressed and has tried to convince the inspectorate that these issues will all be dealt with in the fullness of time without providing real and concrete details.

I agree with all arguments put forward by PEA and unless, and until, the applicant is able to completely satisfy the inspectorate that all issues that have been raised by all interested parties have been properly and fully addressed then I would respectfully request that the inspectorate must refuse this application.
