There are a number of unanswered questions about the height of the substations in respect of the chosen plot. Nobody knows what they will look like. The question of blight remains unanswered. Thank goodness for the Examination Authority and their excellent questioning. I hope that most of these matters will be resolved/answered by the applicants by the relevant deadlines.
