aug to oct once again it proves how little confidence the public have in the applicants to deliver this project saftley I know you are aware of these incidents and they should be red flags

bird strike risk could be a real threat and I don't feel it can be mitigated

due to the amount of geese and birds in the area and not knowing how they will behave to this disruption of the land And the SABIC pipeline have agreed terms but along this route there are clear signs no excavation to take place again an accident waiting to happen hidden behind NDAs and the people of the fylde need to have their health and safety taken seriously

I still have concerns around the equality act and people with special characteristics they were excluded they will be affected by this running past their homes with noise and vibration etc and have not been in a position to have their say also the impact on the Wrea Green Equitation Centre

Which could close due to this project because of the affects it will have on the horses it would be a big loss to the fylde and all the people who use this facility especially the riders who fall under people with special characteristics

I hope that you have had a glimpse of the inability to accept advise and engage with people

these applicants representatives seem to have been incapable to do so and they just think they know the fylde and it's land best and they can't even do a local impact assessment on our area only for tourism and businesses they would be happy to ruin our economy

when they think they are right about something they just double down

they might have had a more positive response from the public if they had conducted a proper consultation and answered questions and not just dismissed people and try and keep everything on the down low

we are just expected to except what they want to unleash on us for years
