We are instructed by Network Rail Infrastructure Limited ("Network Rail") in relation to the Morgan Offshore Wind Project and Morecambe Offshore Windfarm: Transmission Assets Order 202[] ("the Order").

We write further to Network Rail's Relevant Representation in March 2025 which set out Network Rail's grounds of objection to the Order.
