Proposal: Application by Morgan Offshore Wind Limited and Morecambe Offshore Windfarm Limited (“the Applicants”) for an Order Granting Development Consent for the Morgan and Morecambe Offshore Wind Farms Transmission Assets (“the Proposed Development”)

We write further in response to your letter dated 12 March 2026, in relation to a request for information on the above matter.

The query for the Canal & River Trust (The Trust) is no.37 below.

37 - The Canal and River Trust and the Applicants are requested to provide updates regarding whether protective provisions have been agreed, and whether the Canal and River Trust have any outstanding objections

The Trust can confirm that the draft Development Consent Order, submitted at Deadline 6 of the Examination by the Applicant (Document Number MRCNS-J3303-BGS-10001A MOR001-FLO-CON-ENV-RPT-0020; Reference C1/F09 dated 22 October 2025), contains at Schedule 10 Part 12 the agreed protective provisions for the protection of the Canal & River Trust. This matter has therefore been addressed.

The only outstanding matter for the Canal & River Trust relates to the land negotiations for rights over our leased land, Carter Jonas (our agents), were in discussion with Dalcour McClaren (the applicants' agents) in relation to the draft Heads of Terms (HoT). Despite requests for update on this matter, this has not been forthcoming.
