Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing to formally object to the proposals for the Morgan and Morecambe Offshore Wind Farms Transmission Assets. As a local resident residing at [REDACTED]

I strongly oppose the current plans for the following reasons:

- **Environmental and Amenity Impact:** The proposed use of local beaches and sand dunes will irreparably damage cherished natural habitats, negatively impact local wildlife, and heavily disrupt tourism.
- **Disruption and Traffic:** The sheer scale of the onshore construction will cause severe traffic congestion and years of disruption to our local roads, which are already under strain.
- **Lack of Local Mitigation:** The developer has failed to adequately consult with local communities and provide robust plans to mitigate the severe environmental and community impacts of this project.

Given the proximity of my [REDACTED] postcode to the impacted coastal zones, I urge the Planning Inspectorate and the Secretary of State to reconsider the current onshore routing and require the developer to pursue less destructive alternatives, such as estuarine routing.

I request that my concerns be fully registered as part of the ongoing Development Consent Order (DCO) process.
