I would like my concerns adding to the feedback you are collating.

1. Awareness

I don't believe that local people have enough awareness or understanding about this proposed project. Most who live on my estate (and it is of significant size and will be directly impacted) have not heard about this project despite claims from the applicant about awareness campaigns in the area. What evidence is there of a wide spread on-going marketing campaign, that clearly states the strategy, objectives, goals and timeframes (in simple terms) to all residents in the area? Did these materials have a 'call to action' so that people would actively have to acknowledge that they received and understood the communications? Was there a plan to update and engage with people on a personal (and ongoing) level in the area, to make sure the level of understanding was adequate?

I attended one presentation in the past 5 years and although I was able to put questions forwards, no response or further communication has taken place. This is why the level of awareness falls short of anything I would expect with a project of this size and with such huge implications.

The beach, nature reserve, traffic infrastructure, birds, animals, sand dunes, flood defences, noise, pollution are all things that concern me.

2. Alternative route

There is an alternative that will be far less disruptive, which has been put to the applicant and yet, there has been no change to the proposal to reflect further consideration to this alternative.

I would like to see these concerns being taken seriously.

I have copied in my MP, Mr Snowden as I'm hoping that a full response concerning the alternative route will be forthcoming. It is not a case of opposing alternative energy, it is more about making sure that projects like these are placed in the best areas with the least disruption to all life and that the applicant is more transparent with awareness campaigns.
