I am writing to you about your forthcoming decision on the Morgan and Morecambe Offshore Windfarm Development Consent Order.

As a resident of the Fylde Coast I can fully understand and agree with the concerns that residents, farmers, businesses and local councils have about the scale of damage this underground cabling would cause to productive farmland and fragile rural landscapes. It would also disrupt communities for years and place huge pressure on local roads and infrastructure.

I believe that an alternative plan has been put forward by Lancashire County Council, Fylde Borough Council and Wyre Borough Council, a northern route via Rossall and Hillhouse Enterprise Zone, which suggests significantly better outcomes including a substantial saving in infrastructure costs, reduce underground cabling by around 25 kilometres, create much needed employment opportunities and support the long term growth of the Hillhouse Technology Enterprise Zone.

I urge you to delay any decision about the Morgan and Morecambe scheme to allow proper investigation of the alternative northern route and the substantial economic, environmental and strategic benefits it could deliver.
