My thanks for giving your attention to these matters.

I am still awaiting any form of response from [REDACTED] at which I must say I am not entirely surprised. I will certainly keep you in the picture when I do hear anything.

In response to your comment regarding assistance, there is perhaps some help that you may be able to provide. I and the TASC group have been keen to establish some form of meaningful discussion around the problem of the Morgan and Morecambe application and the resolute refusal to consider to an obvious alternative, which despite all responses and protests, clearly had and has not been examined recently in sufficient depth within DESNZ. If they had, all they needed to do was put the evidence on the table, which they have failed to do.

There is a web woven around the subject which confuses issues, compounding unrelated pieces of information to try and make a consistent story to cover the basic omissions, regarding the possibilities of Hillhouse/Stanah and the presence of the Warton Aerodrome with all that implies.

These issues were raised before the DCO process commenced, but sadly, we were not aware of the formal process that required everything to be written down by ourselves. Instead, we had relied upon good faith in bringing these issues to the attention of their project team verbally at the initial presentation they made at Newton & Clifton Village Hall, which they clearly ignored. We have become older and wiser now!

Is there anything that you could do to help bring about such a discussion?
