

## 1 BACKGROUND

- 1.1 On 1 October 2014 National Grid wrote to the Planning Inspectorate to advise that, subject to the conclusion of contractual documentation between National Grid and EDF Energy, the connection date for the Proposed Development was likely to change from 31 October 2019 to 1 June 2022. National Grid explained at that time that the construction programme for the Proposed Development, as presented and assessed in the submitted *Environmental Statement (Volumes 5.1 to 5.27)* would also be revised in such circumstances.
- 1.2 In light of this possible change to the Project connection date, National Grid undertook analysis of the information contained within the submitted *Environmental Statement* to determine what the implications of the revised construction programme might be on the assessment of the likely significant effects of the Proposed Development. This analysis was presented in the following documents which were submitted to the Planning Inspectorate on 1 October 2014:

- 1.3 The above information is collectively referred to within this report as the Environmental Statement Sensitivity Test (**ESST**) documentation.
- 1.4 By letter dated 15 January 2015, National Grid wrote to the Planning Inspectorate to confirm that revised contractual documentation giving effect to the proposed change to the Connection Date had been agreed between National Grid and EDF Energy.
- 1.5 In its letter of 29 January 2015, pursuant to Rule 8 of the Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010, and in order to enable anyone who might be affected by the revised construction programme to have a fair opportunity to make their views known and properly taken into account, the Examining Authority requested that National Grid, at the earliest practicable opportunity, advertise the details of the revised construction programme in newspapers, on a non-statutory basis, but in the same manner prescribed by Regulation 17 of the Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2009 (as amended).

- 1.6 National Grid was also requested to compile any responses to the newspaper notification and provide this report to the Examining Authority.
- 1.7 This report explains the advertisement undertaken by National Grid in respect of the ESST documentation and provides a copy of the responses received in response to that advertisement.

## **2 ADVERTISEMENT UNDERTAKEN**

### **2.1 *Form of Notice***

- 2.1.1 In accordance with Regulation 17(3)(b) of the Infrastructure Planning Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2009, National Grid prepared a notice which set out the following information:
  - (a) the name and address of the applicant;
  - (b) that the applicant has made an application to the Secretary of State for an order granting development consent for EIA development;
  - (c) that the Secretary of State has accepted the application and the reference number of the application;
  - (d) a summary of the main proposals, specifying the location or route of the proposed development;
  - (e) that additional environmental information is available for inspection free of charge at the places (including at least one address in the vicinity of the proposed development) and times set out in the notice;
  - (f) the latest date on which those documents will be available for inspection (being a date not earlier than the deadline given for responses);
  - (g) whether a charge will be made for copies of any of those documents and the amount of any charge;
  - (h) details of how to respond to the publicity; and
  - (i) a deadline for receipt of responses being not less than 28 days following the date on which the notice was last published.
- 2.1.2 National Grid did not include the information prescribed in Regulation 3(b)(iv) within the notice as it was not relevant to the current circumstances.
- 2.1.3 A copy of the text of the ESST notice can be found at **Appendix 1** to this report.

### **2.2 *Publication of Notice***

- 2.2.1 In accordance with Regulation 17(3)(c) of the Infrastructure Planning Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2009 (as amended), National Grid published the notice:
  - (a) for two consecutive weeks (namely during the weeks commencing Monday 9 February and Monday 16 February 2015) in 19 local

newspapers circulating in the vicinity in which the development is situated;

- (b) once in a national newspaper (during the week commencing Monday 9 February 2015) ; and
- (c) once in the London Gazette (during the week commencing Monday 9 February 2015).

2.2.2 A full list of the publications within which the notice appeared, including the dates of publication of the notice, is provided at **Appendix 2** to this report whilst examples of the published notice are provided at **Appendix 3**.

2.3 ***Deadline for Responses***

- 2.3.1 The notice invited anyone who wished to comment on the additional environmental information to provide comments in writing to Freepost H POINT CONNECTION or by email to [hinkleyconnection@nationalgrid.com](mailto:hinkleyconnection@nationalgrid.com).
- 2.3.2 The deadline for receipt of responses was Friday 20 March 2015, being not less than 28 days from the date of publication of the last notice on Friday 20 February 2015 in accordance with the requirements of Regulation 17.

**3    RESPONSES RECEIVED**

3.1 National Grid has received 1 response to the ESST advertisement. On 27 February 2015 Mark Parish Council submitted a letter making representations in relation to the proposed revised construction programme. A copy of the representation received can be found at **Appendix 4** to this report.

### NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT IN RELATION TO A REVISED CONSTRUCTION PROGRAMME

On 28 May 2014 National Grid Electricity Transmission plc ("National Grid") of 1-3 Strand, London WC2N 5RH applied to the Secretary of State, c/o The Planning Inspectorate ("PINS"), for a development consent order ("DCO") under the Planning Act 2008 ("the Application"). The DCO would authorise works to the national electricity transmission system between Hinkley Point in Somerset and Seabank near Avonmouth ("the Project"). The Project is required to provide sufficient transmission capacity to enable the connection of new electricity generation projects in the region including the consented Hinkley Point C nuclear power station that is being developed by EDF Energy. The Application was accepted for examination by PINS on 19 June 2014.

The Project is "EIA development" for the purposes of the Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2009. This means that the proposed works constitute development for which an Environmental Impact Assessment is required. Accordingly, the application was accompanied by an Environmental Statement, containing information about the environmental effects of the Project.

Following receipt of an application by EDF Energy to modify the terms of the Bilateral Connection Agreement which contains the Project connection date and determines the overall construction programme, National Grid submitted a revised connection offer to EDF Energy on 19 August 2014. In light of these developments, on 1 October 2014 National Grid submitted additional information relating to the potential change to the overall construction programme for the Project to PINS.

On 9 January 2015 National Grid wrote to PINS to advise that EDF Energy had formally accepted the revised connection offer, resulting in a change to the overall construction programme for the Project.

On 29 January 2015, the Examining Authority appointed to examine the Application requested that National Grid advertise the details of the revised construction programme in newspapers, on a non-statutory basis, but in the same manner as under Regulation 17 of the Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2009 (as amended).

Notice is hereby given that the connection date for the Project has moved from October 2019 to October 2022.

Comments are invited on the additional information as explained below.

#### Additional Information

The additional information submitted to PINS is in the form of an Environmental Statement Sensitivity Test (**Volumes 5.29.1 and 5.29.2**). This contains an analysis of the impact of the revised construction programme on the information provided within the submitted Environmental Statement.

Full details of the revised construction programme can be found within the additional information National Grid submitted to PINS on 1 October 2014. This information was published on the National Infrastructure pages of the Planning Portal website here:





The Application was accepted for examination by PINS on 19 June 2014.

The Project is "EIA development" for the purposes of the Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2009. This means that the proposed works constitute development for which an Environmental Impact Assessment is required. Accordingly, the application was accompanied by an Environmental Statement, containing information about the environmental effects of the Project.

Following receipt of an application by EDF Energy to modify the terms of the Bilateral Connection Agreement which contains the Project connection date and determines the overall construction programme, National Grid submitted a revised connection offer to EDF Energy on 19 August 2014. In light of these developments, on 1 October 2014 National Grid submitted additional information relating to the potential change to the overall construction programme for the Project to PINS.

On 9 January 2015 National Grid wrote to PINS to advise that EDF Energy had formally accepted the revised connection offer, resulting in a change to the overall construction programme for the Project.

On 29 January 2015, the Examining Authority appointed to examine the Application requested that National Grid advertise the details of the revised construction programme in newspapers, on a non-statutory basis, but in the same manner as under Regulation 17 of the Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2009 (as amended).

Notice is hereby given that the connection date for the Project has moved from October 2019 to October 2022.

Mark Parish lies in section B, south of the Mendip Hills AONB and sits on the northern edge of Mark Moor on the Somerset Levels.

At the Preliminary Meeting 17<sup>th</sup> January at the Winter Gardens in Weston- super- Mare, National Grid requested an extension to their connection to Hinkley Point C because of EDF modified terms. This was unacceptable to the floor as a whole and to the Planning Inspectorate who advised National Grid that a consultation would have to take place with the general public. This has been undertaken by National Grid in the form of national newspaper advertisements under Public Notices.

The time frame being proposed is now 76 months, extended by 25 months, which is in excess of the time frame in the **DCO volume 5.29**.

This will have a detrimental effect on the residents along the route; more so those living in close proximity to the haul roads and works compound, any delays will put an added burden on households and public areas as well as further disruption to road traffic, the A38 being the main road in this area.

Mark Parish Council objects to this request for an extension to the construction time table.
