I am writing regarding the following proposed Nationally Significant Infrastructure Projects:

- Arrow Valley Solar
- Tarchon Interconnector Project

The applicants for the above proposed developments intend to make an application for Development Consent under the Planning Act 2008. The applicants sought a Scoping Opinion from the Planning Inspectorate, on behalf of the Secretary of State, as to the

scope and level of detail of the information to be provided within the Environmental Statement that will accompany its future application. The Planning Inspectorate is required to identify consultation bodies which must be consulted before adopting its Scoping Opinion.

We have recently become aware that, although the Inspectorate did identify Sphere Energy Connect Limited as a consultation body for these proposed developments, the consultation letters were sent to an incorrect address.

The Planning Inspectorate has now adopted its Scoping Opinion for both projects. Although the consultation has now ended, you may wish to provide the Planning Inspectorate with comments on the applicant's Scoping Report. Any response that the Planning Inspectorate receives will be forwarded to the applicant for information and will be published on the Planning Inspectorate's National Infrastructure Planning website with an acknowledgement of the technical error as the cause for the late response in that instance.
