Deadline 1 – Responses on behalf Runnymede Borough Council (RBC)

Gateley Hamer is instructed by RBC to act on behalf of the Council in respect of the land included within the draft Development Consent Order (dDCO) for the proposed replacement aviation fuel line being promoted by Esso (the Applicant).

Included in this letter are RBC's responses to Deadline 1 of the Examination:

- **Notification of wish to speak at a Compulsory Acquisition Hearing (CAH)**

RBC is engaging with the Applicant in respect of the land required for the scheme owned by RBC. However, there are significant concerns over some of the land included within the dDCO Book of Reference, including but not exclusively, the use of land at Chertsey Meads.

At this time, RBC objects to the use of all of its land and the application for compulsory acquisition powers over all of RBC owned land. As an agreement with Esso remains outstanding, RBC intends to attend and provide evidence at the Compulsory Acquisition Hearing.

- **Notification of wish to attend the Accompanied Site Inspection (ASI)**

RBC wishes to accompany the Examining Authority for the Accompanied Site Inspection. RBC will provide details to the Applicant in advance of proposed attendees representing RBC.

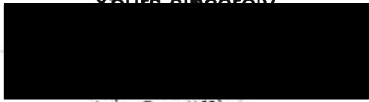
- **Submission of suggested locations/sites for the ExA to include as part of the ASI including the issues to be observed there, information on whether the site can be accessed on public land and reasoning for each nominated site**

RBC wish to invite the Examining Authority to include within the itinerary for the ASI the following sites:

- a. Cockcrow Hill to Sandgates including Salesian School
- b. Canford Drive and Roakes Avenue, Chertsey
- c. Abbey Rangers Football Club and playing pitches, and
- d. Chertsey Meads.

RBC will provide a narrative of key issues per site in advance of the ASI, and will also provide access details to the Applicant.
