Holm Wood/Three Acre Copse, Chawton House	Impact on Ancient Woodland	No - access via a farm track	Proximity of pipeline route to, and impact on, Ancient Woodland
'Persuasion' coppice row, Chawton House	Impact on cultural landscape feature (noted in Jane Austen novel)	No - access via farm track	Look at principle of excavations and hedge treatment
Meon Valley Trail, Chawton	Impact on undesignated trees & woodland	Yes – a public right of way	Impact on trees and woodland where the proposed pipeline crosses a former railway line (now a popular walking and cycling route)
Byway north of West Tisted	Landscape and visual impacts on the National Park	Yes – a public right of way	Example view of the pipeline route within the National Park
A272 at Brockwood Park	Example of TPO/notable trees at risk	Yes - off the A272	Location where proposed pipeline has trenchless crossing under A272 through line of TPO trees
Woodland at Betty Mundy's Bottom, north of Stake's Lane	Impact on Ancient Woodland (both designated and potential ancient woodland)	Yes – from the Wayfarers Walk public right of way	Proximity of pipeline route to, and impact on, Ancient Woodland
