# Sirs

I am writing on behalf of Bourne Education Trust in regards to the Southampton to London Pipeline (SLP) Project and in particular the proposed amendments to the Limits of Deviation across the Abbey Rangers Football Club pitches at Addlestone Moor.

Esso has approached us with a number of mitigation proposals which will allow for the football club to continue to operate as normal during the construction work. One of the crucial elements of these proposals is a trenchless crossing of the first team pitch (pitch no.2 on the attached plan).

We understand from our dialogue with the SLP Project that in order to accommodate trenchless construction across part of our playing fields a small change to the Limits of Deviation will be required. We are now writing to you to support the SLP Project's application to amend the Limits of Deviation.

Pitch no.2 on the attached plan is maintained to a suitable standard to play both FA Cup and Football Pyramid Level 9 matches. The pitch is required for the duration of the first team season, which runs from August until early May. The pitch is a crucial facility for the operation of Abbey Rangers FC business and sporting activities and provides a venue for semi-professional teams.

If the proposed amendment is not approved and the SLP Project needs to dig a trench across pitch no 2 in order to install the pipeline we are concerned that the narrow window during the off-season could be insufficient to complete the required work and the extensive reinstatement required to bring the pitch back to playable condition prior to the season starting in early August. Failure to complete this work would leave the football club exposed to punitive action from the Football Association.

We therefore support the SLP Project's proposal to alter the pipeline's Limits of Deviation to allow them to complete a trenchless crossing to ensure that pitch no. 2 will remain available to the club throughout the construction period.
