Southampton to London Pipeline Application - Amendment to Land Rights at the Proposed Location of 'Valve 3'

I am the owner of Lower Preshaw Farm, Lower Preshaw Lane, Upham and am writing with regard to the Southampton to London Pipeline (SLP) Project and in particular the proposed amendments to land rights at the location of 'valve 3' which is proposed on my land.

Esso are proposing a number of mitigation proposals which will greatly reduce the long-term impact on my estate. One of the crucial elements of these proposals is the location of a turning area next to the valve. At my request Esso are designing the pipeline and valve to be as close as possible to the nearby woodland so that the additional amenity planting required to maintain the visual appearance of the landscape is most effective. In order to achieve this Esso will need the rights to construct and take permanent rights of access to a turning area a few meters to the north of the current limits of deviation. The desired layout is shown on plan SLP-2019-12-MT-EP-VALVE 3.

We understand from our dialogue with the SLP Project that in order to accommodate the turning area in the position that we would like, a small change to the rights Esso have applied for will be required. We are now writing to you to support the SLP Project's application to amend these rights.

If the proposed amendment is not approved and the SLP Project is therefore compelled to construct the turning area on the South side of the valve, there will be an increased detriment to the landscape and the visual amenity of the estate which is entirely avoidable.

I hope that you find the above agreeable and I look forward to progressing this with you soon.
