We are the owners of [REDACTED].

We are forwarding an image of the route the proposed pipeline will take across our property ie. our garden .

It affects the entrance to our property with no other access possible.

We strongly feel this will also blight the property and devalue any resale of our property.

Esso said we could only deal with them via a solicitor this has already lead to heavy costs and we have had to now

stop our solicitor from acting for us as ESSO are no longer agreeing to cover these expenses .Plus at a meeting at our home

with Esso representatives they advised us to get an independent valuation which they would pay for we have done this and they

now to not wish to cover these costs.

At a recent Planning Inspectorate meeting in Farnborough Esso said we were about to appoint an agent to act on our behalf

this is not true because we cannot risk any further expense.

Attending three public meetings didn't solve anything and this has been ongoing for nearly two years.

We are really not sure how we should now proceed with this matter and await your comments or advice.
