Response to the Letter dated 13 January 2020 in respect of:

Request to Make Changes to the Original Application and Examining Authority's Request for Additional Information – Logistics Hubs

Dear Sir /Madam,

This document sets out Surrey County Council's (SCC) response to the above request. Surrey County Council is responding to the letter in its role as Highway Authority, especially considering the revised traffic assessments submitted and potential changes in traffic impact.

Officers at the County Council have reviewed the proposed changes to the application and the revised traffic assessments, and after careful consideration have come to the view that the changes result in fewer logistics hubs within Surrey, and therefore result in fewer traffic movements at the previously chosen sites. Therefore, the amendment is deemed from the transport impact point of view, not to be detrimental to Surrey's interests as highway authority.

The County Council does not consider that it is part of its role to determine whether the changes amount to a material change. However, the Examining Authority has specifically requested a view from the County Council. In which case the professional view from officers is that within Surrey the changes would not amount to a material change.
