NOTICE OF PUBLICATION OF STATEMENT OF COMMUNITY CONSULTATION

Liverpool Bay CCS Limited is proposing to deliver and operate a new carbon dioxide ('CO<sub>2</sub>') pipeline between Ince, near Stanlow, and Flint, and to repurpose an existing 24" natural gas pipeline for CO<sub>2</sub> between Flint and Point of Ayr Terminal.

The development for which a Development Consent Order ('DCO') will be sought is:

a. Construction and use of Ince Above Ground Installation ('AGI') to Stanlow AGI pipeline (up to 20").

b. Construction and use of Stanlow AGI to Flint AGI pipeline (36").

c. Construction and use of Flint AGI to Flint Connection pipeline (24").

d. The repurposing and use for CO<sub>2</sub> of the Flint Connection to Point of Ayr Terminal pipeline (24").

e. Construction and use of Ince AGI.

f. Construction and use of Flint AGI.

g. Construction and use of Stanlow AGI.

h. Construction and use of Northop Hall AGI.

i. Construction and use of Block Valve Stations ('BVSs') located along the existing natural gas Flint Connection to Point of Ayr pipeline and Stanlow AGI to Flint AGI pipeline.

Items a-i together form the **'Pipeline'**.

j. Other infrastructure such as Cathodic Protection (CP) transformer rectifier cabinets.

k. Ancillary works integral to the construction of the Pipeline including construction compounds, and access tracks.

All of items a-k together form the **'Proposed Development'**.

We intend to apply to the Secretary of State for a DCO which would authorise the construction and operation of the Proposed Development under the Planning Act 2008. The DCO application will include the construction and operation of a new CO<sub>2</sub> pipeline, AGIs and BVSs and repurposing and use of an existing natural gas pipeline. The DCO will include powers required to construct and operate the Proposed Development including compulsory acquisition powers for the permanent acquisition of land and / or rights over land and powers to convey CO<sub>2</sub> through the length of the existing natural gas pipeline. The DCO may also include (if required) powers for the temporary occupation of land, the extinguishment or overriding of easements and other rights over or affecting land required for the Proposed Development, the application and / or disapplication of legislation relevant to the Proposed

Development, highway powers and tree and hedgerow removal, amongst other matters.

We have produced a Statement of Community Consultation ('SoCC') which explains how we will consult the local community about the Proposed Development before we finalise our proposals and make a DCO application. The consultation will take place from **9 February 2022 to 22 March 2022**.

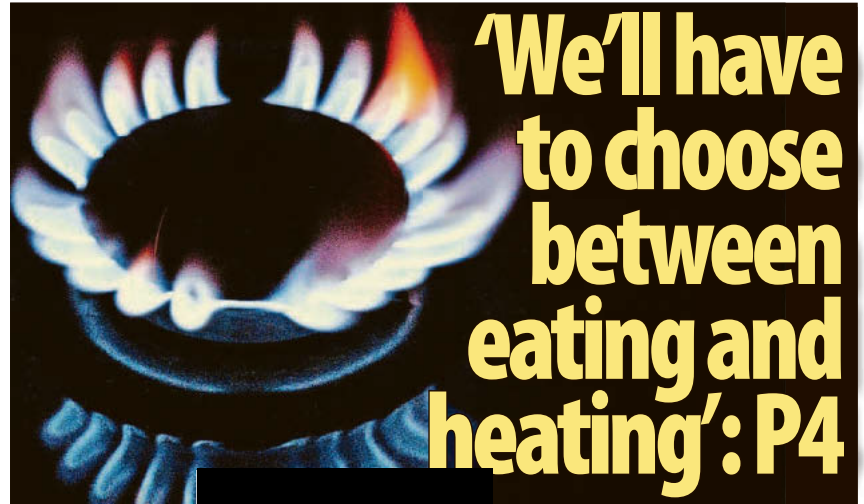

## Johnson tries to take back control amid party outrage

Boris Johnson will attempt to seize back control of the government agenda this week with a policy blitz, an exit bill and flying visit to Ukraine. Westminster remains in the grip of paralysis over the Sue Gray and police inquiries into No 10 parties.

Amid frustration in Number 10 over the uncertainty surrounding the report into rule-breaking parties in Downing Street, sources said Johnson was determined to deflect public outrage with a schedule of high-profile announcements and photo opportunities designed to show MPs remained focused.

Johnson yesterday announced plans for legislation to make it easier to rip up EU regulations and restrictions, amid criticism from conservative MPs that the government has not taken sufficient advantage of Brexit.

He is also expected to visit Ukraine as the foreign secretary, Liz Truss, this week, with the levelling-up paper also scheduled for publication on Wednesday.

Whitehall sources said they also expected developments this week on help for families struggling with the cost of energy bills after the prime minister and the chancellor definitively ruled out cancelling the national insurance rise and cutting VAT on energy bills.

Johnson could receive the long-awaited report into lockdown breaches in No 10 as soon as today after which he is expected to give an immediate statement to MPs.

Scotland Yard's special inquiries team will this week scour evidence of lockdown-breaking by Johnson's aides, sent to them by the Gray inquiry. Detectives received the information from the Cabinet Office on Friday and police chiefs have been stung by fierce and widespread criticism after pressing for Gray's report to give only "minimal reference" to the gatherings under investigation.

Those are believed to be the most clear-cut breaches of the lockdown rules, and therefore the most likely to pose political danger to Johnson. The police request caused widespread fury in Westminster and the report's contents are expected to be significantly weakened. **6**

## Thousands still have no power as new storm hits

Up to 25,000 homes are still without power in Scotland and north-east England in the wake of Storm Malik as they brace for winds of up to 90mph with the arrival of Storm Corrie.

Northern Powergrid confirmed 7,000 homes were still without power yesterday evening. Earlier, Scottish and Southern Electricity Networks (SSEN) said 18,000 customers were off supply in Scotland. Both networks warned the incoming storm could hinder their ability to restore power.

Those affected are mainly in

Northumberland and County Durham, and rural Aberdeenshire.

Paul Glendinning, a director at Northern Powergrid, said the restored supplies to more than 60,000 customers by yesterday morning, but warned that a relatively small proportion of our customers will remain

1. Notice is hereby given that Liverpool Bay CCS Limited, whose registered office address is at Enl House, 10 Ebury Bridge Road, London, SW1W 8PZ, (the 'Applicant') proposes to make an application (the 'DCO Application') under section 37 of the Planning Act 2008 to the Secretary of State for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy ('Secretary of State') for a Development Consent Order ('DCO') to authorise the installation and operation of a new carbon dioxide ('CO<sub>2</sub>') pipeline between Ince, near Stanlow, and Flint, and to repurpose an existing 24" natural gas pipeline between Flint and Point of Ayr Terminal for transportation of CO<sub>2</sub>.
2. The development for which the DCO will be sought is:
- Construction and use of Ince Above Ground Installation ('AGI') to Stanlow AGI pipeline (up to 20').
  - Construction and use of Stanlow AGI to Flint AGI pipeline (36').
  - Construction and use of Flint AGI to Flint Connection pipeline (24').
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  - Construction and use of Block Valve Stations ('BVSs') located along the existing natural gas Flint Connection to Point of Ayr pipeline and Stanlow AGI to Flint AGI pipeline.

Items a-l together form the 'Pipeline'.

- Other infrastructure such as Cathodic Protection (CP) transformer rectifier cabinets.
  - Ancillary works integral to the construction of the Pipeline including construction compounds, and access tracks.
- All of items a-k together form the 'Proposed Development'.

3. As the Proposed Development is a pipeline project crossing local authority boundaries and approximately 60km in length, it is classed as a Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project under section 14(1)(g) and section 21 of the Planning Act 2008 ('PA2008'). The Applicant must therefore apply to the Secretary of State for a DCO, in order to construct, operate and maintain the Proposed Development.

4. The DCO Application will seek the authorisation of the Proposed Development through the DCO. The DCO Application will include the construction and operation of a new CO<sub>2</sub> pipeline, AGIs and BVSs and repurposing and use of an existing natural gas pipeline. The DCO will include powers required to construct and operate the Proposed Development including compulsory acquisition powers for the permanent acquisition of land and / or rights over land and powers to convey CO<sub>2</sub> through the length of the existing natural gas pipeline. The DCO may also include (if required) powers for the temporary occupation of land, the extinguishment or overriding of easements and other rights over or affecting land required for the Proposed Development, the application and / or discontinuation of legislation relevant to the Proposed Development, highway powers and tree and hedgerow removal, amongst other matters.

5. The Applicant intends to apply separately for planning permission via the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 ('TCPA') for works to the existing Point of Ayr Terminal and works to the foreshore area between the Point of Ayr Terminal and mean low water mark at Point of Ayr. The TCPA application will also include extension of the duration of existing consents.

**Environmental Impact Assessment**

6. The Proposed Development is 'EIA development' for the purposes of The Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017 (the 'EIA Regulations') and an Environmental Statement ('ES') will form part of the DCO Application for the Proposed Development. The Applicant has notified the Secretary of State in writing under Regulation 8(1)(b) of the EIA Regulations that it proposes to provide an ES in respect of the Proposed Development.

7. The ES will provide a detailed description of the Proposed Development and its environmental effects, as well as other matters required by the EIA Regulations. The Applicant has prepared a Preliminary Environmental Information Report ('PEIR'), which sets out the Applicant's preliminary view of the likely significant effects of the Proposed Development based on the assessment undertaken to date as well as a non-technical summary of the PEIR. # 'It upset people' Outrage at tidy-up of Scottish sacred well

At the end of a steep woodland trail, surrounded by sturdy beech and ash trees, a spring bubbles into a basic stone well, rippling in the low winter sunlight. On nearby branches and around the mouth of the well, colourful cloth rags - or cloots - have been hung by visitors, as an offering to a water spirit or local saint and an entreaty to be healed.

The clootie well near Munloch, on the Black Isle peninsula near Inverness, is a place of traditional pilgrimage. It is also now a cause of community consternation, after a well-meaning stranger cleared away many of the offerings.

"I'm sure the person who cleared up thought they were

doing something good," says Claire Mackay, a herbalist who lives on the Black Isle, "but the fact they took it upon themselves and did it without the permission of Forestry and Land Scotland [which manages the site] has upset a lot of people."

Some on the community Facebook page have even suggesting the individual may henceforth be cursed for "desecrating" the sacred site - while others acknowledge the site was already in need of attention.

The well had gathered an accumulation of eccentric offerings during lockdown, including bras, pants and a hi-vis jacket.

Verity Walker, a local author and heritage consultant, can remember the clootie trees being trimmed or cleared when she passed the well as a child. It is an ancient tradition that now coexists alongside modern faiths, she says. "When my daughter injured her foot, I hung

a sock - it has to be biodegradable and related to the part of the body that you want to recover."

Mackay is optimistic that the initial outrage can be channelled into a more organised approach to maintaining the site. "The clean-up should have been a community decision," she says. "But now we can treat it as a clean slate and hope it has planted that seed about the need for people to leave more natural things."

Paul Hibberd, a regional visitor services manager for Forestry and Land Scotland, points out that there is already signage

asking people to leave "only small, biodegradable offerings" at the well. The build-up of debris "highlights how much plastic is in modern clothes", he adds. "That's part of the problem with items not breaking down."

Clootie wells, which are also found in Cornwall and Ireland, date back into pre-Christian times and the practice of leaving votives. The healing well at Munloch was been linked to St Boniface, who was a missionary in Scotland around AD600, and is likely an example of early Christianity absorbing more ancient Celtic traditions. Pilgrims performed a ceremony that involved circling the well three times, before splashing water on the ground and saying a prayer.

There are now plans for a community group to care for the area, with more than 100 people expressing an interest.

Mackay would like to see storytelling at the well and input from local historians, as well as outreach into schools to explain to children how to leave votives and cloots without harming the environment.

"It's a symbolic act," says Walker, "an act of meditation and connection, an act of faith even if you're not sure what you have faith in, and that's only to be encouraged."

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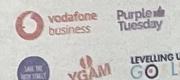

**NOTICE OF PROPOSED APPLICATION FOR A DEVELOPMENT CONSENT ORDER FOR THE HYNET NORTH WEST CARBON DIOXIDE PIPELINE**

1. Notice is hereby given that Liverpool Bay CCS Limited, whose registered office address is at Eni House, 10 Ebury Bridge Road, London, SW1W 8PZ, (the ‘**Applicant**’) proposes to make an application (the ‘**DCO Application**’) under section 37 of the Planning Act 2008 to the Secretary of State for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy (‘**Secretary of State**’) for a Development Consent Order (‘**DCO**’) to authorise the installation and operation of a new carbon dioxide (‘**CO<sub>2</sub>**’) pipeline between Ince, near Stanlow, and Flint, and to repurpose an existing 24” natural gas pipeline between Flint and Point of Ayr Terminal for transportation of CO<sub>2</sub>.

2. The development for which the DCO will be sought is:

a) Construction and use of Ince Above Ground Installation (‘**AGI**’) to Stanlow AGI pipeline (up to 20”).

b) Construction and use of Stanlow AGI to Flint AGI pipeline (36”).

c) Construction and use of Flint AGI to Flint Connection pipeline (24”).

d) The repurposing and use for CO<sub>2</sub> of the Flint Connection to Point of Ayr Terminal pipeline (24”).

e) Construction and use of Ince AGI.

f) Construction and use of Flint AGI.

g) Construction and use of Stanlow AGI.

h) Construction and use of Northop Hall AGI.

i) Construction and use of Block Valve Stations (‘**BVSs**’) located along the existing natural gas Flint Connection to Point of Ayr pipeline and Stanlow AGI to Flint AGI pipeline.

Items a-i together form the ‘**Pipeline**’.

j) Other infrastructure such as Cathodic Protection (CP) transformer rectifier cabinets.

k) Ancillary works integral to the construction of the Pipeline including construction compounds, and access tracks.

All of items a-k together form the ‘**Proposed Development**’.

3. As the Proposed Development is a pipeline project crossing local authority boundaries and approximately 60km in length, it is classed as a Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project under section 14(1)(g) and section 21 of the Planning Act 2008 (‘**PA2008**’). The Applicant must therefore apply to the Secretary of State for a DCO, in order to construct, operate and maintain the Proposed Development.

4. The DCO Application will seek the authorisation of the Proposed Development through the DCO. The DCO Application will include the construction and operation of a new CO<sub>2</sub> pipeline, AGIs and BVSs and repurposing and use of an existing natural gas pipeline. The DCO will include powers required to construct and operate the Proposed Development including compulsory acquisition powers for the permanent acquisition of land and / or rights over land and powers to convey CO<sub>2</sub> through the length of the existing natural gas pipeline. The DCO may also include (if required) powers for the temporary occupation of land, the extinguishment or overriding of easements and other rights over or affecting land required for the Proposed Development, the application and / or disapplication of legislation relevant to the Proposed Development, highway powers and tree and hedgerow removal, amongst other matters.

5. The Applicant intends to apply separately for planning permission via the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (‘**TCPA**’) for works to the existing Point of Ayr Terminal and works to the foreshore area between the Point of Ayr Terminal and mean low water mark at Point of Ayr. The TCPA application will also include extension of the duration of existing consents.

**Environmental Impact Assessment**

6. The Proposed Development is ‘EIA development’ for the purposes of The Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017 (the ‘**EIA Regulations**’) and an Environmental Statement (‘**ES**’) will form part of the DCO Application for the Proposed Development. The Applicant has notified the Secretary of State in writing under Regulation 8(1)(b) of the EIA Regulations that it proposes to provide an ES in respect of the Proposed Development.

7. The ES will provide a detailed description of the Proposed Development and its environmental effects, as well as other matters required by the EIA Regulations.
