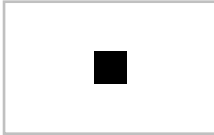

Protective Provisions for IOT Operators

We act for the Applicant in connection with the above application for development consent. The Examination of the application closed on 26 September 2024 and the Examining Authority submitted its recommendation report to the Secretary of State for Energy Security and Net Zero on 5 December 2024.

Following the close of the Examination, the Applicant has agreed terms of a legal agreement with Associated Petroleum Terminals (Immingham) Limited and Humber Oil Terminals Trustee Limited (referred to together as "the IOT Operators"). Amongst other things, the parties have agreed that protective provisions for the benefit of the IOT Operators should be included in the Development Consent Order, if granted. Please take this email as a formal request on behalf of the Applicant that the attached protective provisions be included in the Development Consent Order in substitution for Schedule 9, Part 12 of the draft DCO (Revision H) [REP6-002]. 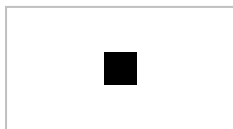

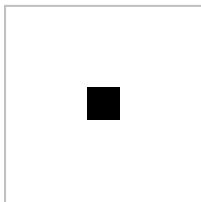
