Please see below comment from Wynyard Parish Council (Stockton)

Please note we could not comment until having a council meeting yesterday, hence this is after your 11th March deadline.

The planned blue hydrogen production facility, jointly owned by Kellas Midstream and SSE Thermal, will be sited at Seal Sands, with hydrogen eventually being pumped through two main pipelines, to Wilton in the east, and Cowpen Bewley in the west. From Cowpen Bewley, further pipelines will distribute hydrogen to more remote locations. When will the locations of these further pipelines be known? Are any of these hydrogen pipelines planned to be located at Wynyard Village and/or Wynyard Park? If so, when will we be informed of (a) the intended locations at Wynyard; (b) the duration and impact of any installation works on Wynyard residents. Wynyard already has an HP gas pipeline (marked by vertical red and white poles) running through it - any Wynyard hydrogen pipelines must be installed at a safe distance from the HP gas line.
