

I have reviewed the document and really only have a couple of updates for you.

Generally, everything is in-line with our SCI but there is one error. The SoCC states that documents will be available for inspection at the Central Library but this closed on the 9 June. So the table listing the deposit points should delete the Central Library and replace it with the new Riverside Library which is based here in the Council House with the following opening times Monday to Friday 8.30am to 5.00pm, Saturday 9.00am to 1.00pm.

Also, the list of deposit points includes the Council Offices. Given that the new Riverside Library is in the Council House, I suggest that reference to the Council House is deleted.

Finally, and this isn't under the remit of the SoCC, I suggest that we put something on our homepage, under 'What's happening in Derby?' but this will need to be sorted out by us through our Comms in advance of the consultation starting.

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

To whom it may concern.

South Derbyshire District Council wishes to submit the following response to the current consultation on the A38 Derby Junctions Scheme Statement of Community Consultation.

"South Derbyshire District Council would request that:

- the parish councils in the A38 corridor within South Derbyshire, these being Burnaston, Egginton, Etwall, Findern and Willington, be included as consultees to be written to inviting feedback;
- (ii) the consultation documents be made available for inspection at Etwall Library and that
- (iii) South Derbyshire District Council be kept informed of the activities of the stakeholder working group through invitations to meetings and provision of meeting minutes".

This would reflect the fact that, although the scheme will take place entirely within Derby City, these parish councils would be likely to be the most affected within South Derbyshire in terms of impacts on trips they may be making both during and after construction. Placing the consultation documents in Etwall Library would provide those living within the above mentioned parishes the opportunity to the view and respond to the details, were they unable to access the material online. Including South Derbyshire District Council as a invitee to the stakeholder working group and as a recipient of meeting minutes would allow the Council to keep abreast of and influence developments in regard these strategically significant proposals."

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

Dear Paul Nagra

Thank you for consulting Erewash Borough Council on your Statement of Community Consultation for the A38 Derby Junctions scheme.

Please consider this e-mail as the Borough Council's formal response to that consultation.

Within your method statement, you have identified a number of venues for public information exhibitions. I am pleased to see Little Eaton Village Hall included as a venue exhibition.

However, though I note that Breadsall Priory has been included, there are no public information exhibitions planned for Breadsall Village. The priory is 2 miles away from the village, and I would not consider this to be convenient for the residents of Breadsall Village. I strongly recommend the addition of a venue in the village, e.g. Breadsall Memorial Hall at DE21 5LF.

Under "council and community area / forum briefings" you have stated that local councils will be offered briefings. It would be useful if you clarified here that this includes Parish Councils.

Under "establishing stakeholder groups" you have stated that you will provide briefings to Little Eaton and Breadsall Parish Councils if invited. For the avoidance of doubt, and to avoid contradiction your statement under "council and community area / forum briefings", this should state that the parish councils will be <u>offered</u> briefings.

Finally, I am please to note that documents will be available for inspection at both Breadsall Village Shop and Little Eaton Post Office.
