4. Confirming why the Planning Inspectorate should receive the application



The scheme is a nationally significant infrastructure project ("NSIP") within sections 14(1)(h) and 22(1)(a) of the Planning Act 2008. Under section 22 an NSIP must fall within one of the three categories specified, which are expressly stated to be alternatives. This scheme is the "construction" of a highway within the meaning of section 22(1)(a). The scheme satisfies section 22(2) in that the highway will (when constructed) be wholly located in England, Highways England as strategic highways company will be the highway authority for the highway and the area of development is greater than the relevant limit set out in subsection (4), which in this case is 12.5 hectares, as speed limits will be in excess of 50mph.

5. Non-technical description of the Proposed Development



The Scheme would be approximately 8 miles (13km) long and would comprise the construction of a new two-lane dual carriageway for the A303 between Amesbury and Berwick Down. Key elements are:

- a) A northern bypass of Winterbourne Stoke with a viaduct over the River Till valley;
- b) A new junction between the A303 and A360 to the west of and outside the WHS, replacing the existing Longbarrow roundabout;
- c) A tunnel approximately 2 miles (3.3km) in length past Stonehenge; and
- d) A new junction between the A303 and A345 at the existing Countess roundabout.

6. Location or route of the Proposed Development



The location of the scheme is shown on the Location Plan (Application Document 2.1). The Scheme starts on the A303, to the south of Yarnbury Castle, approximately 350m west of the junction with Byway SLAN3, bypasses Winterbourne Stoke to the north and then closely follows the existing A303 route from Longbarrow junction to east of Solstice Park, ending approximately 300m east of the access from the A3028.
