1 Funding Statement Addendum

1.1 Purpose of this document

- 1.1.1 The Section 51 advice issued by PINS on 20 November 2018 requests that Highways England provides an addendum to the Funding Statement (Application Document 4.2) concerned specifically with the availability of funds for Compulsory Acquisition/compensation for the proposed development..
- 1.1.2 The Funding Statement confirms and provides evidence of the Government's commitment to funding the implementation of the A303 Amesbury to Berwick Down scheme (the Scheme). As explained at paragraph 3.2.2(a) of the Funding Statement, that commitment includes the funding of all land acquisition costs.
- 1.1.3 Highways England confirms that those land acquisition costs include all compulsory acquisition costs, blight claims and compensation payments.
- 1.1.4 The Funding Statement and this addendum therefore make it clear that funds will be available to meet all compulsory acquisition costs, blight claims and compensation payments for the Scheme.
