Dear Sirs ,

The only discussion held was on 7th March 2019 which is recorded by minutes produced by Highways England. There have been no further discussions held since and at the Compulsory Acquisition Hearing if my understanding of the evidence put forward by Highways England is correct, it was stated returning this land to any agricultural condition including chalk grassland was not possible which is a fundamental change to the evidence previously put forward by Highways England.

On behalf of my client I have now sought to establish if Highways England believe they will be able to return the land not required for the construction of the new A303 to my client as chalk grassland post construction.

I would suggest that Highways England should be examined further on this specific point to establish what exactly their intentions are for this area of land belonging to my client.
