Further to your invitation, disgracefully sent at short notice during the period of national mourning, to comment on the National Highways letter dated 9th September 2022.

- National Highways has simply reiterated many of the arguments it has raised previously to justify a scheme which is clearly unacceptable to:

- Government's independent specialist examiners,
- UNESCO's World Heritage Committee, and
- the former Transport Secretary himself who agreed with the examining panel that the scheme would be "significantly adverse" overall.

- There is no recognition of the increasing urgency of the climate emergency which the Secretary General of the United Nations has described as "Code Red for Humanity". The Stonehenge scheme is incompatible with the measures which must be taken to avert climate and ecological disaster.

- There is no recognition of the importance of the sacred landscape of Stonehenge.

- The nation faces a cost of living crisis, the money on the scheme could be better spent in very many ways.

I urge you to scrap this ecocidal project.
