Dear Rt Hon Anne-Marie Trevelyan MP, Transport Secretary,

I am emailing you in response to your request for comments on the proposed work on the A303 & the stone henge site following the visit by the Advisory Mission.

I have read the report and The Mission advises that a less damaging scheme, such as a southern bypass, should be sought and The Mission indicated that, at the very least, any tunnel should be extended to the western WHS boundary.

As I understand it National Highways is currently insisting that its current plan would bring benefits to the WHS, and that a longer tunnel would not be worth the expense.

This is very obviously not the case.

I was born in Somerset, although I am a London voter, not only is this site important to me and my family personally, but this site is a very important part of our shared history. To fall at this hurdle would be a travesty for future generations.

I would also like to note that the timing of this request for comments from your office is during a period of national mourning and, looks from the outside, to be rather devious timing.
