I write to reiterate the findings of the Advisory Mission, that the tunnel as proposed would damage the Outstanding Universal Value of the marvellous Stonehenge World Heritage Site.

National Highways, an excellent organisation in so many ways, perhaps has limited interest in, and knowledge of, a World Heritage Site. It has repeated its previous arguments which have already been judged unacceptable by UNESCO's World Heritage Committee, the Government's own specialist advisers, and the former Transport Secretary.

Any damage to the Stonehenge site cannot be repaired. Part of the site would be gone for ever, so I hope that this unsatisfactory scheme will be abandoned.

If not, may I urge a formal Public Examination so that new information submitted by National Highways and others may be considered properly and taken into account by the Government's independent Planning Inspectorate.
