The UNESCO Advisory Mission latest report reiterates that the A303 Stonehenge proposed scheme as it is now would have a seriously adverse impact on the World Heritage Site. Although National Highways tries to spin the report in favour of the scheme this is not what it says.

At the least, the tunnel should be longer so that major cuttings and earthworks are outside the Stonehenge landscape.
