
1. Introduction


- 1.1.1 Highways England (the "Applicant") has applied to the Secretary of State for a Development Consent Order ("DCO") to authorise a scheme for alterations to the M25 junction 28 (the "Scheme"). The application is submitted to the Planning Inspectorate (the "Inspectorate") in accordance with section 37 of the Planning Act 2008 (the "2008 Act").
- 1.1.2 This document comprises part of the suite of application documents and is submitted in compliance with Regulation 5(2)(k) and Regulation 5(4) of the Infrastructure Planning (Applications: Prescribed Forms and Procedure) Regulations 2009, which require:
 - 5(2)(k)- 'where applicable, a plan identifying any new or altered means of access, stopping up of streets or roads or any diversions, extinguishments or creation of rights of way or public rights of navigation'.
 - 5(4) 'Where a plan comprises three or more separate sheets a key plan must be provided showing the relationship between the different sheets'.
- 1.1.3 This document is to be read in conjunction with other application documents, in particular, Schedule 1 (Authorised Development), Schedule 4 (Permanent Stopping Up of Highways and Private Means of Access and Provision of New Highways and Private Means of Access) and Schedule 5 (Classification of Roads, etc.) to the draft DCO (application document TR010029/APP/3.1).







